Report on Inter-Institutional Competitions under Nasha Mukht Bharat Campaign

On 20th April 2026, Government Degree College Frisal, in collaboration with the District Police Kulgam and District Administration Kulgam, successfully organized a series of Inter-Institutional Competitions, including Speech, Essay Writing, Slogan Writing, and Painting Competitions. The event was conducted under the aegis of the “**100 Days Intensive Campaign**” of **Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan**, aimed at raising awareness about substance abuse and promoting a drug-free society. The programme was graced by the presence of distinguished guests, including Mr. Javed Iqbal, Tehsildar Frisal; Mr. Rajat Chib, DySP; and Mr. Bhat Shabir, Sub Inspector, Police Post Frisal. The programme commenced with an introductory address by the Principal of the college, **Dr. Fayaz Ahmad Butt**, who highlighted the significance of such awareness initiatives and emphasized the collective responsibility of society in combating drug abuse. A detailed presentation on drug abuse was then delivered by the **Sub Inspector Mr. Bhat Shabir**, which sensitized the participants about the causes, consequences, and preventive measures related to substance abuse. Following these informative sessions, the various competitions commenced with enthusiastic participation from students representing different institutions. The entire session was effectively moderated by **Dr. Zahid Hussain**.
